Qualifications:

5. Has the interest and competence to carry out lifeguarding duties.
6. Is at least 15 years old.
7. Possesses Red Cross or equivalent deep water lifeguard certification.

Responsibilities:

1. Be a witness for Jesus Christ in all words and actions.
2. Help maintain a Christ-like, servant atmosphere in the work area.
3. Be courteous and friendly to everyone.
4. Attend all staff meetings, on time.
5. Keep the pool area clean and orderly at all times.
6. Be safety conscious, performing all the duties of a professional lifeguard.
7. Open the pool at required times.
8. Enforce all pool rules, ensuring the pool is utilized in a safe and enjoyable manner.
9. Always be rescue-ready when on duty and prepared to respond to any emergency.
10. Perform all necessary pool chemistry checks and keep accurate daily records.
11. Maintain the pool as trained, including skimming and operating the Dolphin.
12. Be prepared for late night and early morning swim times.
13. Be ready to guard on river activities, such as downriver tubing.
14. Depending on staffing, join the Cleaning Crew to clean bathrooms after breakfast.
15. Contact your supervisor if there is any situation in which you do not know what to do.
16. Be ready and willing to help with tasks not included in this job description!
